## Take Advantage Of Your Lenten Journey!

We are more than halfway through Lent. How is your Lenten journey going? Are you able to reflect on sacred scripture? Go to daily Mass? Spend some quiet time with Jesus in prayer? Lent offers such a wonderful time to focus on reflection and reconciliation. Use Lent to bring yourself closer to Jesus!

Registration for 2010-2011 shows 45 families and 63 students. We've enrolled four new families! Please help us by registering as soon as possible and also help recruit new families to OLOL. There are rewards for bringing a new family to OLOL as well as just having them take a tour. **Our goal with the bus program at St. Frances Cabrini Parish and our new preschool is to have 140 students enrolled for the 2010-2011 school year.** If you will need financial assistance, please apply through the sources we offer: Schmitz Family Foundation and Parish Assistance if you qualify. The registration fee will be \$150 per family. Tuition has been set at \$4,000 for affiliated and \$5,000 for non-affiliated. After the tuition papers have been completed, Mrs. Crandell will send home the school registration forms for the 2010-2011 school year. Thank you in advance for all your support!

**There will be a Soup Supper and Stations of the Cross every Friday (with the exception of Good Friday) during Lent. The soup supper begins at 6:00 p.m. and Stations of the Cross are at 7:00 p.m. Our Lady of Lourdes parish wishes that school parents continue to attend these events for the remainder of Lent.
